## Freestyle Judges Scoring Cheat Sheet

In <u>level 1</u>, judges may award up to ten points in each subcategory. Half point increments may be awarded.

- 0 .5: Almost no evidence of the skills could be observed
- <u>1 3</u>: Only brief flashes of evidence of the skills could be observed
- <u>4 6</u>: Although these skills were evident by the human, dog or team during their round, all examples from the rubric were not observed and or the skills were not evident during the majority of the routine
- <u>7 9</u>: Throughout the majority of the routine, these skills were evident. There may have been brief moments throughout the routine where these skills lapsed.
- 9.5 10: The human, dog, or team showed mastery of these skills throughout the entire routine.

In <u>level 2</u>, judges may award up to five points in each subcategory. ("Tricks" is the only exception as 10 points may be awarded in that subcategory.) Half point increments may be awarded.

- 0: Almost no evidence of the skills could be observed
- 1: Only brief flashes of evidence of the skills could be observed
- <u>2-3</u>: Although these skills were evident by the human, dog or team during their round, all examples from the rubric were not observed and or the skills were not evident during the majority of the routine
- 4: Throughout the majority of the routine, these skills were evident. There may have been brief moments throughout the routine where these skills lapsed.
- 5: The human, dog, or team showed mastery of these skills throughout the entire routine.
